Wall then managed Framfab's Swedish and international consulting business. Framfab was the largest Europe based internet and new media services company with some 3500 employees world-wide. In 2000, he was appointed CEO of Framfab, where he led the reorganization of the company for two years.

Johan Wall is a board member of several private and publicly traded companies in the high technology and industrial manufacturing space.

Wall holds a Master of Science degree from the Royal Institute of Technology, Sweden. In 2002-2003 he was a Visiting Scholar at Stanford University, California.
